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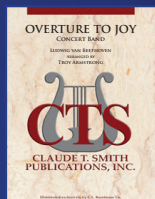

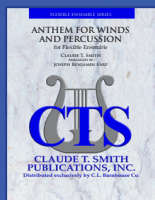

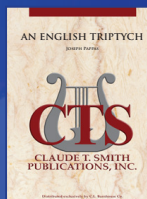

CLAUDE T. SMITH



Claude T. Smith was born in Monroe City, Missouri on March 14, 1932. He began his undergraduate degree at Central Methodist College in Fayette, Missouri, eventually enlisting in 1952 and serving in the 371st U.S. Army Band during the Korean War. After his service, he completed his Bachelor of Music Education degree at the University of Kansas in Lawrence.

Smith composed over 180 works for band, orchestra, choir, solos, small ensembles as well as three method books for band and orchestra. His compositions have been commissioned and performed by leading musical organizations throughout the world including the U.S. Air Force Band, the "President's Own" U.S. Marine Band, the U.S. Navy Band, and the U.S. Army Field Band. His solos were written for noted artists such as "Doc" Severinsen, Dale Underwood, Brian Bowman, Warren Covington, Gary Foster, Rich Matteson, and Steve Seward.

Smith was first published in 1964 with his work for band *Emperata Overture*. This led to many other works being published by Jenson Publications, Inc. (now Hal Leonard) and Wingert-Jones Music, Inc. where he was also an educational consultant. His composition *Flight* was adopted in 1984 as the "Official March" of the National Air and Space Museum of the Smithsonian Institute. His orchestral works were written for many ensembles, including the Kansas City (MO) Youth Symphony, South Bend (IN) Youth Symphony, Springfield (MO) Symphony Orchestra, and the 1981 Missouri All-State String Orchestra.

Smith taught instrumental music in the public schools of Nebraska and Missouri. He also served as a member of the faculty of Southwest Missouri State University

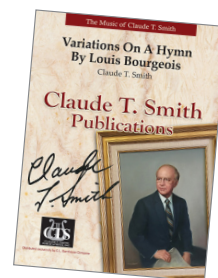
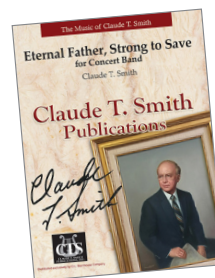
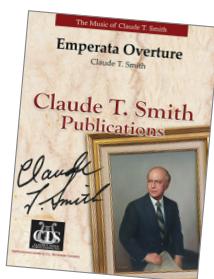
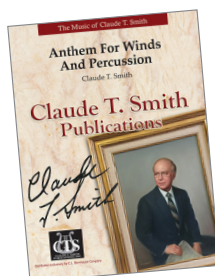
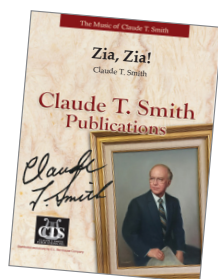
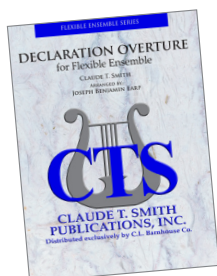
in Springfield where he taught composition and theory, and conducted the University Symphony Orchestra. Sacred music was also a deep passion of Smith as he directed church choirs for five years in Cozad (NE), 10 years in Chillicothe (MO), and 10 years in Kansas City (MO).

Smith was active as a clinician and guest conductor throughout the United States, Australia, Canada, and Europe. He received many awards for his contributions to music education and for his work in composition including numerous ASCAP Composers Award. Following his death, he was awarded the National Band Association Academy of Wind and Percussion Arts (AWAPA) Award (1987), honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters from Central Methodist College (1988), Missouri Bandmasters Association Hall of Fame (1988), Kappa Kappa Psi Distinguished Service to Music Medal (1988), Missouri Music Educators Association Hall of Fame (1992), and named School Director of the Year from the Christian Instrumental Directors Association (1994).

Smith was a member of the Music Educators National Conference (now NAfME), Missouri Bandmasters Association, National Band Association, American Bandmasters Association, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and served as past president of the Missouri Music Educators Association.

Claude T. Smith passed away on December 13, 1987 in Kansas City, Missouri having completed a Christmas Concert at church. His wife, Maureen Faye Smith and his daughter, Pam Smith Kelly, along with Pam's husband, Jim, founded Claude T. Smith Publications, Inc. in 1993, and C.L. Barnhouse Co. became the exclusive distributor for his instrumental works in 2016 with the mission of keeping the music of Claude T. Smith alive and in the hearts of musicians worldwide.

Joseph Benjamin Earp is the Music/Music Industry Chair and Director of Bands at Hinds Community College in Raymond, Mississippi. He received his undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, Master of Music in Music Education from Anderson University (Anderson, South Carolina), and Doctor of Music Education degree from Liberty University (Lynchburg, Virginia).

His professional teaching career began in 2006 as Director of Bands at Seneca High School in South Carolina. After two years, he taught at Robbinsville Middle and High Schools for a year before becoming the founding Director of Bands at Cox Mill High School in Concord, North Carolina. After eight years of numerous achievements at Cox Mill High School, he moved into his role at Limestone University (Gaffney, South Carolina) as Director of Athletic Bands, elevating many elements of Limestone's athletic band program. Just prior to his role at Hinds Community College, Dr. Earp was the Director of Instrumental Music at Pfeiffer University in Misenheimer, North Carolina.

In addition to teaching, Dr. Earp is an active published composer and clinician with his music being performed internationally. His major compositional accomplishments include being the winner of the 2010 Claude T. Smith Composition Contest in Missouri, winner of the 2018 Thornton Community Band Composition Contest in Colorado, multiple J.W. Pepper Editors' Choice awards, and multiple works selected to be part of the Band World Magazine Top 100. He currently resides in Clinton, Mississippi with his wife Mary Beth and sons Jackson and Jasper.

Jim LeBon is originally from Pennsylvania and attended twelve years of Catholic school before starting at Florida State University in 1977. He received his bachelor's degree in Music Education in 1982, studying clarinet with Harry Schmidt and Ted Lane, and arranging with Charlie Carter. He later returned to FSU to complete a master's degree in Music Education in 1993.

LeBon was a high school band director in northern Florida and southern Georgia for fourteen years before moving to Port St. Lucie (FL) in 1997. He taught at

Dan McCarty Middle School for eleven years and fifteen years at Southport Middle School. Mr. LeBon had a great deal of success with his students and is proud of the numerous superior and excellent ratings that they have achieved in concert band and solo and ensemble festivals.

LeBon retired from teaching after forty successful years and continues to write music for band, teach privately, and mentor band directors who are working to become better teachers and managers of their careers and lives. LeBon maintains an active schedule as an adjudicator at Florida Bandmasters Association concert and marching festivals as well as at solo and ensemble events. He also plays baritone sax with the Ambassadors of Swing, and clarinet and bass clarinet with the Treasure Coast Wind Ensemble. LeBon conducts the Stuart Community Concert Band which is an adult ensemble dedicated to the performance of great band literature. Mr. LeBon is a member of the American School Band Directors Association.



Mark Grauer has been a music educator since 1979, teaching band, choir and orchestra in public schools in Arkansas, Massachusetts, and Wisconsin. He received his undergraduate degree from the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, and received a Masters in Music Education from VanderCook College of Music in Chicago. Mr. Grauer is a published author, composer and arranger, with his works for concert band published by Daehn Publications and Claude T. Smith Publications. He received a Legion of Honor award in 2013 from the John Philip Sousa Foundation for his contributions to the teaching profession through dedication to bands and band music.

Joseph Pappas (b. 1950) has written over three hundred compositions for various types of ensembles from beginning bands to college wind ensembles. Known for his compositions for young bands and musicians, his works have been performed in the U.S., Canada, China and throughout Europe.

Mr. Pappas actively serves as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the Midwest. Professional memberships include NAfME, MMEA, East Central MMEA, ASCAP, Phi

Mu Alpha, Phi Beta Mu, honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi, MBA, Central States Adjudicators, and MSHSAA Adjudicators.

Mr. Pappas has been a four-time Teacher of the Year recipient, recipient of the Emerson Electric Excellence in Teaching Award, the MSHSAA Distinguished Service Award, a Sadie Rafferty Music Composition Contest winner and named 3 times to Who's Who Among American Teachers and Who's Who In America.

Bands under his direction have won numerous awards including three times Overall Champions at Music In the Parks festivals and two time recipient of the Southern Illinois University - Edwardsville Bi-State Band of the Year Award. Pappas was presented the Earl and Margie Holland School of Visual and Performing Arts Alumni Merit Award from Southeast Missouri University, the St. Louis Suburban Music Educator's Association Merit Award and elected to the SLSMEA Hall of Fame.

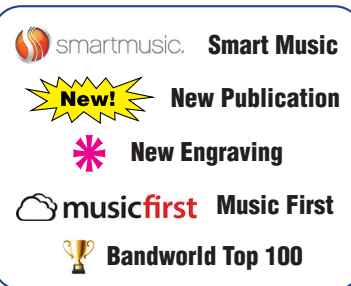
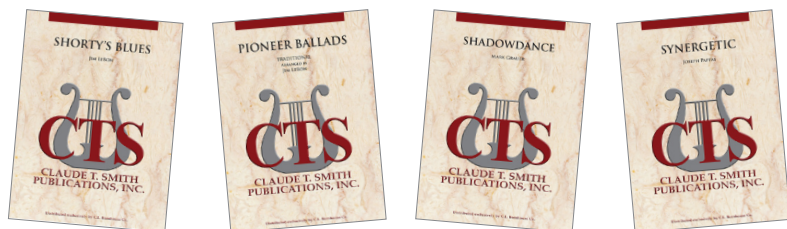

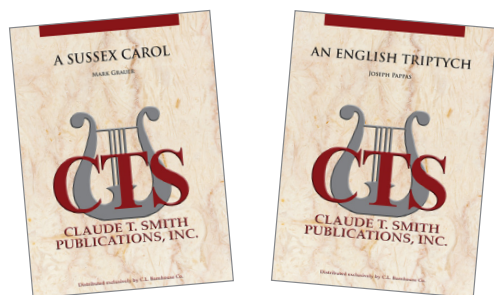

Troy Armstrong (b.1990, Tulsa, OK) is a composer, arranger, and conductor currently based in Nashville, TN. He has won numerous awards for his original compositions including the MENC Collegiate Composition Competition, and the University of Southern California's New Music for Orchestra and New Music for Wind Ensemble Competitions. In 2013, Troy's orchestra piece, "Supercell", was named the winner of the Marilyn K. Glick Young Composer's Competition. As the winning entry, it received performances by the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra during their 2014 subscription season concerts.

Troy enjoys collaborating with all manner of ensembles and organizations. He has had the privilege of composing music for groups such as the Blue Valley School District in Overland Park, KS, the A.I.M Ensemble in Los Angeles, HEAR NO EVIL, the Music for Special Occasions trio in Kansas City, and the Church of the Resurrection Choirs and Orchestra in Lenexa, KS. His works have been performed in the USA, Canada, Central America, Australia, and Europe in venues including the Kennedy Performing Arts Center in Washington, D.C. and Cadogan Hall in London, England.

Troy's oratorio, "The River of Light," was premiered on April 23, 2017, by a group of over 200 musicians. The 16-movement piece was written to dedicate the unveiling of the Resurrection Window at the Church of the Resurrection in Leawood, KS. Designed and fabricated by Judson Studios in California, the Resurrection Window is currently the largest single stained-glass window in the world measuring approximately 37 feet tall and almost 100 feet wide.

During the University of Kansas' 2007-2008 basketball season (the year the team won the NCAA National Championship), he was the premiere composer for their Jayhawk Basketball Television Network. Troy is currently composer/arranger with the Church of the Resurrection music department in Leawood, KS. He arranges music for their choir and orchestras on a weekly basis.

In his spare time, Troy enjoys cooking, writing poetry, designing puzzles and board games, and hiking the wooded trails around his home. Troy is a member of ASCAP and the Pi Kappa Lambda music honors society. She is a bassoonist and is the President of Claude T. Smith Publications, Inc., which publishes the instrumental and choral works of her late father. 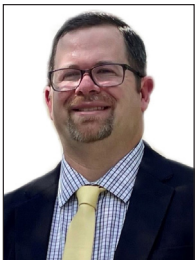

He served as Director of Instrumental Activities at Grand View University in Des Moines, Iowa for seven years, teaching Applied Brass, Music Theory, Instrumental Methods, Conducting, Music Appreciation, and directed the Wind Ensemble and Jazz Ensemble. Previously, he taught in the secondary schools of Florida and North Carolina for 14 years. In addition to his teaching and directing workload, he serves as the Project Manager and Publications Editor for Claude T. Smith Publications, Inc.

He has completed coursework (ABD) for his Ph.D. in Music Education from the University of Florida, Master of Music Education from Appalachian State University, and Bachelor of Music Education from Louisiana State University.

Doerffel has presented at conferences in several states, including Arkansas, Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, South Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Florida, and North Carolina on topics that range from classroom management, score preparation & study, new teacher preparation, and trombone & brass pedagogy.

He has served the Iowa Bandmasters Association (IBA) as Past President and College Affairs representative for the South Central district and was the State Chair for the College Affairs Committee. His professional affiliations include NAFME, National Band Association, College Band Directors National Association, College Music Society, North Carolina Bandmasters Association and the International Trombone Association.



Joseph Benjamin Earp – Arranger and Media Specialist is the Music/Music Industry Chair and Director of Bands at Hinds Community College in Raymond, Mississippi. He received his undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, Master of Music in Music Education from Anderson University (Anderson, South Carolina), and Doctor of Music Education degree from Liberty University (Lynchburg, Virginia). In 2019, Dr. Earp was inducted into the Omega Nu Lambda National College Honor Society based on his academic achievement at Liberty University. In 2020, he was named a Distinguished Alumni Award recipient by the College of Arts and Architecture at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.

His professional teaching career began in 2006 as Director of Bands at Seneca High School in South Carolina. After two years, he then taught band at Robbinsville Middle and High Schools for a year before becoming the founding Director of Bands at Cox Mill High School in Concord, North Carolina. Major accomplishments teaching at the secondary level include one of his symphonic bands auditioning and being selected to perform at the 2013 North Carolina Music Educators State Conference, multiple superior ratings, grand championships, awards, and recognitions from his instrumental ensembles.

After eight years of numerous achievements at Cox Mill High School, he moved into his role at Limestone University (Gaffney, South Carolina) as Director of Athletic Bands, elevating many elements of Limestone's athletic band program. A major accomplishment of the Limestone University Marching Saints was auditioning and being selected to lead one of the afternoon parades at Walt Disney World's Magic Kingdom in January of 2019. Just prior to his role at Hinds Community College, Dr. Earp was the Director of Instrumental Music at Pfeiffer University in Misenheimer, North Carolina. Tasked with reviving the instrumental music program at Pfeiffer, he re-established the wind ensemble and pep band. Additionally, he wrote Pfeiffer's first fight song which was adopted by the school's student government association. Dr. Earp also ensured the instrumental building at Pfeiffer received much-needed renovations.

In addition to teaching, Dr. Earp is an active published composer and arranger with his music being performed internationally. His works are made available by BKJ Publications, Carl Fischer, CTS Publications, and RWS Music Company. Both CTS Publications and RWS Music Company are distributed worldwide by C. L. Barnhouse. Dr. Earp's major compositional accomplishments include being winner of the 2010 Claude T. Smith Composition Contest in Missouri, winner of the 2018 Thornton Community Band Composition Contest in Colorado, multiple J.W. Pepper Editors' Choice awards, and multiple works selected to be part of the Band World Magazine Top 100. He currently resides in Clinton, Mississippi with his wife Mary Beth and sons Jackson and Jasper.
